Your health needs are important to us. Recently, we announced the decision for St. Vincent Charity Medical Center to solely provide ambulatory care. This transition will be completed by November 15, 2022. We want you to know that you can expect continued high-quality, compassionate care now and throughout the transition.

We want to share that we will retain vital services to maintain access to care for our community. Our ambulatory care services remaining will include primary care, our Health Care Center, behavioral health and addiction medicine services. These ambulatory services will remain open and accepting new patients.

During this transition, we will keep our patients updated on the status of our employed physician group as well as the status of our Emergency Department, Psychiatric Emergency Department, and the transition of surgeries currently scheduled for our Hospital. If you have a scheduled appointment or procedure, we ask that all questions should be directed to your physician. They can best answer your questions on next steps.
