Mission Award

Arlene Jaroscak presented the first Light of Hears Villa *Making God's Love Visible* Mission Award to Joanne Reardon on January 4, 2012, during the Annual Missioning Ceremony for Staff and Volunteers. Joanne was nominated by her peers for this Award, which is the highest honor bestowed on a staff member.

"Making God's Love Visible" comes from St. Vincent de Paul, the great saint of charity, who called his followers to make God's love visible and to seek the face of Christ in the face of every person they met.

Joanne began her years at Light of Hearts in January, 1990, four months after the Villa opened.

- Q: How did you feel about receiving the first *Making God's Love Visible* Mission Award?
- A: It was a surprise and a humbling experience. Every day you do what you can for others, not realizing the impact you may have on them.
- Q: What is the most valuable gift the Villa has given you throughout the years?
- A: Getting to know the residents as they aged in place has increased my knowledge of graceful aging.
- Q: With all your experience with residents and their families over the years, what advice would you offer to families with a member who will need Assisted Living services?
- A: Because you love them and can't be with them full time,



they are missing a fullness of life that they could have with others. Because they are alone, you feel guilty. No one wants to leave their home, but so many have said, "Why didn't I do this sooner?"

Q: Is there any advice you would offer younger workers?

A: Be the best of what you can be. Do the best that you can do.
